No fax or e-mail bids will be accepted.

BID Requirements and Specifications for Police Department Parking Lot Fence

Project not to start or be paid for prior to board approval.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- The Town of Ogden reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in the interest of the Town.
- References to trade names are to set standards and not to limit bids. Bidder may offer alternatives with the Police Department's approval prior to bid.
- The manufacturer and specifications of each component must be stated with the bid as well as the gauge of fence being used.
- There shall be a minimum of 10-year warranty (unless otherwise stated) on material and workmanship from the first day of completion.
- The Town of Ogden reserves the right to approve as an equal, or to reject as not being equal, any article the bidder proposes to furnish which contains major or minor variations from the specifications.
- Two sets of literature and specifications must be enclosed with bid.
- Any exceptions or deviations from these specifications must be stated in writing with bids.
- The equipment being offered must be equal to or better than the listed specifications.
- All bids must include a non-collusion affidavit signed and notarized.
- The contractor must remove all debris and repair the site to original condition when job is complete. Site to be maintained in a safe and secure manner at the end of each workday.
- Compliance with all OSHA and Taylor Law requirements.
- Contractor insurance will be required to be submitted to the Town prior to start of work.
- Prevailing wage rates apply to all contractors on the job site.
- Work is to start within 4 weeks of bid approval and must be completed within 3 weeks.
- All bids must include a 5% bond.

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BID Specifications

- Furnish and install approximately 180' of 10' tall industrial black coated chain link fence fabric class 2b fused & bonded 9-gauge core with 1-4' wide single walk gate with panic bar including black visual barrier.
- All posts to be 4" ss40 black coated.
- 1 5/8" ss40 black coated top, middle and bottom rail
- Furnish and install approximately 115' of 8' tall industrial black coated chain link fence fabric class 2b fused & bonded 9-gauge core fence with 2-20'wide cantilever slide gates with black visual barrier.
- 2 ½" ss40 black coated line posts
- 3" ss40 black coated terminal posts
- 1 5/8" ss40 black coated top, middle and bottom rail.
- Furnish and install 1- heavy duty slide gate operator, model HD-25 HySecurity slide gate operator.
- Furnish and install 1-key pad on gooseneck stand with receiver and 20 transmitters.
- Furnish and install 1-free exit loop.

All posts must be set in concrete 4' deep machine dug.

The bid must include all saftey devices required for the fence and gates.

All electrical hookups, conduit, wiring and connections will be done by the Ogden Maintenance Department. Power from the building will be supplied by the Town of Ogden.
